

Beaded Kumihimo class

Items you will need: Bring to next guild meeting: (So I can help you get started).

Kumihimo disc (there is no local supplier. If several of you want me to, I will order in bulk and bring to October meeting)

8 Bobbins (also called EZ bobs. Again, no local supplier. If several people want me to, I will also order in bulk and bring to Oct meeting)

Magatama beads. (no local supplier. I can order for you, but will need to know what colors). You will need 40 if you are doing these on two strands. If you want to do on more strands, add 40 beads per strand.

8/0 beads (also called Pony beads). I use String bead in Chico for these or get online. You will about 200 of these

6/0 beads I get these at String Bead or online. You will need 200 of these

Button and barrel for closure. We can talk about this. You will need the button when you start, can find the barrel (or large holed bead) at the end.

I have C-Lon and will distribute at October guild meeting, or you can get your own at Beadaholique, or other online bead store as there is no local supplier.

You will also need, but don't need to bring, unless you want me to show you:
Large eye beading needle. I can bring or you can get at String Bead in Chico.

I will give you instructions on how to string your beads at the October meeting, but if you want to start earlier, email me at lori.kwanyin@gmail.com

To finish your bracelet you will need heavy thread in a color that matches your 'warp' which is your C-Lon color. You will need a good needle as well. You will also need some glue. I use G-S Hypo, which you can get at String Bead. Others have used Weld-Bond which I haven't found locally. You can ask at Atal in downtown Chico what they have.
